Students participating in District Auditions must have passed Sightreading and Theory levels appropriate to their school grade and audition level. Audition Level will be determined by the school grade the student is in at the time of the NEXT CONVENTION. Repertoire needs to be from three different musical periods. (See APPLICATIONS & FORMS section.)

For example: a student in grade 4 in the spring must enter Audition Level I-B since he/she would be in grade 5 at the time of the State Convention. The student also must have completed Theory Level 2A and Sightreading Level 3 since those levels meet the grade 5 requirements under Audition Level I-B.

If students have previously completed the theory and sightreading requirements for both the school grade and audition level successfully, they will not be required to pass subsequent theory or sightreading tests until new eligibility requirements must be met for a more advanced level.
